Experienced Bruges OCMW social workers will answer your questions and help you out.

The Bruges OCMW are forerunners of the *Geïntegreerd Breed Onthaal* [integrated broad welcome] or GBO, which provides neutral information on the availability of local social support and services. We work with several core partners to do so: the North-West-Flanders CAW and the Social services of the health insurance funds. This brochure incorporates their contact details too.

## DIENST EERSTE ONTHAAL

[initial reception desk]

The *dienst Eerste onthaal* is your first point of contact if you make use of the services and support provided by the Bruges OCMW.

The staff will help you:

- explore your rights;
- apply for a living wage, an equivalent living wage or an advance on your social benefits;
- apply for financial support (such as the installation premium for homeless persons, reimbursement of medical costs and taking charge of social contributions);
- apply for material support (food package, clothing, and chores at home);
- request a reference address;
- with guidance and support for the homeless;
- apply for the OCMW daycare rate;
- apply for the Pelicano Foundation and administrative follow-up of Pelicano children;
- apply for funeral arrangements in case of insufficient resources.

Do you need general information, do you have other help requests or do you need administrative support? Feel free to come by. We will look at how we can help you and refer you to other services if necessary.

## **€** BUDGET- EN SCHULDHULPVERLENING

[budget and debt support service]

The dienst Budget- en Schuldhulpverlening provides advice on urgent financial support requests, such as negotiations with a creditor.

You can also ask them to have a look at an invoice or a contract.

Our staff will also check your eligibility for:

- budget counselling to help you manage your day-to-day finances and payments:
- budget management to manage the entirety of your income;
- collectieve schuldenregeling [collective debt settlement] or CSR whereby the Bruges OCMW will act as your debt mediator.

## **WOONLOKET** [housing advice desk]

Do you have questions about housing, renting or your rental contract? Or are you looking for a place to live? The *Woonloket* provides customized advice and support.

The Woonloket provides advice on:

- social housing
- the rental legislation and your rent guarantee
- the rent guarantee loan from the Vlaams Woningfonds [Flemish housing fund]
- imminent homelessness
- the Flemish rent subsidy and rent premium.
- moving with Dozen & Co [boxes and co]
- crisis mediation in the event of imminent eviction.
- residential counselling
- rent arrears counselling.

If necessary, the Woonloket will refer you to a specialised service.

## **ENERGIELOKET** [energy advice desk]

The staff at the *Energieloket* will answer all your questions on energy and on saving energy.

They will provide advice and tips on:

- mediation in the event of energy debts:
- budget meters;
- compensation on your heating oil invoice;
- how to report your meter readings (gas, electricity, and water)
- how to compare and switch energy suppliers;
- which documents concerning your gas, electricity and water supply you need to fill out when you move;
- minimum natural gas supply;
- social rates for gas, electricity, and water;
- energy scans;
- group purchases of gas and electricity;
- the *Lokale Adviescommissie* [local advisory committee] (LAC), which review files of people at risk of being cut off.

Social workers provide support to clients receiving a *leefloon* [social integration income]. At the programme guidance counselling sessions, you will get answers to your questions on your income, your debts (if any), your health and your living situation.

During the consultation sessions at the d'Oude Stoasie community centre, you can discreetly talk about your questions or problems and ask for personalized support.

You will draw up a GPMI contract, a 'Geïndividualiseerd Project voor Maatschappelijke Integratie' [individualised social integration project] with the social worker

# MOBILE SOCIALE KRUIDENIER [social grocer] (KABA)

The mobile *sociale kruidenier* sells foodstuffs, cleaning products and toiletries to people on a limited budget. You can shop there upon referral by a social service.

The mobile *sociale kruidenier* KABA is part of the association 't Sas, a partnership between the Bruges OCMW, the City of Bruges, and the North-West-Flanders CAW.

#### Conditions

You come by after a referral and financial review by the Bruges OCMW, the CAW, or another social service.

You will receive a fixed monthly budget to shop at the KABA. How much you receive depends on the size of your family. You will have a free budget and a paying budget. With your free budget, you buy products at a fixed price. With your paying budget you buy products that are at least 25% cheaper than in the store.
